Saints win RHBL 2008/09 "Junior Club Championship"

Saints celebrated a successful 2008/2009 junior season by being named Ryde Hornsby Baseball League "Junior Club Champions".

The Club Championship win follows on from winning "Club of the Year" in the 2007/08 season.

All our junior players and their teams contributed to the Club's success last season.

Eight of the Saints junior teams made their grand finals last season. The 16A & B, 10A and 9 year old teams went on to win their Grand Finals. The 14 A & C, 9 and 8 year old teams were grand final runners up.

The Club's 10A team was undefeated throughout its season.
